



Danish lessons

As a foreign resident in Denmark, you are entitled to receive lessons in the Danish language at Lærdansk Århus.

Your right

Everyone has a right to receive Danish lessons for up to three years. Lessons are free of charge.

Lessons are module-based and can be concluded with a state controlled test.

Sufficient skills in Danish language are essential for the possibilities of getting permanent residence permit or eventually Danish citizenship.

Get started

To enroll in a Danish language class please contact Lærdansk Århus - either by mail, phone or in person at the language center which is situated in the heart of Århus.

Requirements

In order to be entitled to receive instruction in the Danish language, you must:

- Be over 18 years old
- Be in possession of a valid residence permit or certificate of registration in Denmark
- Be registered in the National Register in a Danish municipality
